




RAF 100 in Gloucester

RAF 100 in Gloucester 8 July 2018

Your RAF 100 Events Committee have been busy organising a number of activities to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Royal Air Force in the City of Gloucester. These activities will take place at three locations within the city:

Kings Square. The RAFA Wings Appeal trailer, the ATC Glider Flight Simulator, 501 Sqn vehicle and recruitment stand, and RAF recruitment stand. Your chance to fly a glider and join the auxiliaries!

Eastgate Shopping Centre. Lorraine with our Wings Appeal table also giving out entry forms for the "data sheet" trail, an RFC re-enactment group and the Innsworth Military Wives Choir.

Gloucester Cathedral. The RAFA Concert Band will be playing in the Cathedral grounds to coincide with the parade arrival at the Cathedral and again after the service. The RAFA Gloucestershire RAF 100 Commemorative Tapestry will be displayed in the Cloisters. A booklet providing a pocket history of each station depicted in the tapestry will be available through donation.

The veterans March lead by 501 Sqn followed by the ATC and finally the RAF Veterans of Gloucestershire. You could say the current, the future and the past. The parade will start at Quenns Walk, Eastgate Street, (near Boots) and proceed down Westgate Street to the Cathedral for a short service. The parade will set off at 11.30hrs sharp and will take approximately 15 minutes. The parade will be open to all RAF Veterans regardless of RAFA membership so please invite your RAF Veteran friends.
